You are new in Germany and not yet familiar with rules and regulations?

We are offering courses in which you get better acquainted with life in the German society. Topics range from health system, media use, shopping, traffic, child care and school system to customs and traditions. Furthermore, you will learn some basic German.



Who can participate?

Participation is possible for asylum seekers for whom it is not yet certain how long they will remain in Germany. If there are still places in a course available, also those asylum seekers can participate for whom the participation in an integration course is not (yet) possible.



Where do the courses take place?

In many locations all over Thuringia.



When do the courses take place?

Courses are in the morning or in the afternoon for 3 to 4 hours a day, a total of 20 hours a week. The courses last for several weeks.
